Fee paying parents are now required to pay the equivalent of two weeks fees at the time of registration (prior to your child starting nursery or on his/her first session). This payment will act as a deposit which (providing your fees are settled in full) is refundable when your child leaves the setting.

Admission

Admission is on a first come first served basis. If you decide to place your child with Kiddies Corner you will be required to complete a registration form (can be downloaded from our website) for your child & pay a registration fee of £30 to secure your child's place (non-refundable) & contribute towards administration costs. This fee is not applicable to children accessing Free Early Education hours only. **Free Early Education** We accept children for Free Early Education, available to all children from the term after their third birthday, and to qualifying two year olds under the Free for Two scheme. We also accept childcare vouchers given by employers. Free Early Education hours can be accessed free of charge, for more information please see our registration form. We offer each family the option of a home visit before your child starts to give your child a chance to meet their key person in familiar surroundings, and a chance for parents to go through some paper work and informal chat.

Meals

All our meals are freshly cooked daily in a kitchen that has been fully inspected and can be purchased for £2.00 per day. Alternatively you can provide your child with a healthy nutritious packed lunch in line with the setting's healthy eating policy. If you sign up for your child to attend over meal times you will only be able to change your selection at preselected times throughout the year. We provide breakfast & afternoon tea for those children attending the early or late sessions. In addition we also give the children a selection of fruit to eat during the morning & afternoon sessions. If your child has any extra/additional dietary requirements we will do our best to accommodate them.
