## Accredited Senco

Nicola is one of only a handful of people in Kent to have achieved this accreditation.

Nicola is based at our Stanley Road setting, but works closely with all the staff at the Pre School, to support children with either speech and language, or additional needs.

Nikki will be providing additional support to children and families with additional needs, preparing targeted plans to support the child's development and working closely with outside agencies such as Speech and Language therapists.

Fee paying parents are required to pay the equivalent of two week's fees at the time of registration (prior to your child starting nursery or on his/her first session). This payment will act as a deposit which (providing your fees are settled in full) is refundable when your child leaves the setting.



## Admission

Admission is on a first come first served basis. If you decide to place your child with Kiddies Corner pre-school you will be required to complete a registration form (this can be downloaded from our website) for your child & pay a registration fee of £30 to secure your child's place (non-refundable) & contributes towards administration costs. This is not applicable to children accessing funded hours only.

## Free Early Education

We accept children for Free Early Education, available to all children from the term after their third birthday, and to qualifying two year olds under the Free for Two scheme. We also accept childcare vouchers given by employers.

Free Early Education hours can be accessed free of charge, for more information please see our registration form.

We offer each family the option of a home visit before your child starts to give your child a chance to meet their key person in familiar surroundings, and a chance for parents to go through some paper work and informal chat.

## Meals

Lunch is between 12.30 - 1.00. If your child's session runs between these times please can provide your child with a healthy nutritious packed lunch in line with the setting's healthy eating policy.

All children are encouraged to visit the snack bar in the morning where they will be offered fruit, and milk or water to drink and in the afternoon they will be offered a drink and small snack.

If your child has any extra/additional dietary requirements we will do our best to accommodate them.
